4. SUPPLY CHAIN & CAPACITY UPDATE



MILL CAPACITY

Titanium and nickel alloy mill capacity remains constrained into 2027.



FORGINGS & CASTINGS

Backlogs remain extended. New capacity coming online in late 2026-2027.



MACHINING CAPACITY

Skilled labor and machine availability remain tight globally.

TOP CONSTRAINTS

- Raw material availability
- Melting capacity limitations
- Skilled labor shortages
- Logistics & freight volatility
- Export controls & compliance



Lead times are trending longer for most critical materials and components. Early engagement is key.

5. SPACE INDUSTRY UPDATE



Space launches are up 34% YTD vs. 2025, driving demand for:

- Titanium & Nickel Alloys
- High-Temp Alloys
- Precision Machined Components
- Additive Manufactured Parts

Government investment and commercial space programs continue to expand the addressable market.



OUTLOOK: Sustained growth expected through 2030 across launch, satellite and downstream programs.
